Guest speaker: Prof. Chris Boyatzis

Chris J. Boyatzis, Ph.D., is Professor of Psychology at Bucknell University in Lewisburg, PA, and is a developmental psychologist who studies religious and spiritual development, culture and child development, and parenting, especially the intersection of all three areas.

He is former president of the American Psychological Association's Div. 36, Society for the Psychology of Religion and Spirituality, and is associate editor of the field's major journal, Psychology of Religion and Spirituality. He has authored chapters on child and adolescent religion and spirituality in many of the field's major handbooks, has edited numerous special issues of journals on the topic, and since 2001 has organized a preconference on religious and spiritual development at the meetings of the Society for Research on Child Development.

He first taught in Copenhagen in summer 2010 at the Danish Institute for Study Abroad, and then created Bucknell in Denmark, an intensive study-abroad summer program for his Bucknell students to study childhood in Denmark. He has been directing that program since 2011 and during that time has conducted mixed-methods studies on Danish (and US) parenting and collaborated with various Danish scholars.
